RANKING SYSTEM COMPETITION FOR SCHOLARSHIP

New this year

The ranking system competition for scholarship will be held in two separate seasons such as 6 months every year. The couple will be allowed to compete in only one championship.

The proficiency points will be cumulative from January to June and the awards will be given September 26 & 27 2008 into the World Amateur Medallist Competition. The second season will be held from July to December and the awards presentation will be done January 24th 2009 into La Coupe CDTA.

Requets :

- The amateur couple should be CDDSC member in good standing
- The competition organizers should follow CDDSC competition's rules
